# Why was this done?

There was a requirement for documents that were generated on the report server (using SRS server-side printing) to be accessible for processing from a client machine. In addition, a simple method for reducing the document queue size was required, as well as a few other functionality changes when working with the **SRS Document Queue**.

### What was done?

The following changes were made to the **SRS Document Queue** program:

- · You can now change the priority of an item in the queue, regardless of the status.
- Faxed documents are generated and stored in the document queue without sending them.
- Changes to the **Filter Options** allows further filtering on the destination, date and status of documents.
- A new **Warning** status indicates whether a document has been generated and stored, but there was a problem with printing/emailing.
- New operator activities have been added to control access to functionality.
- The **Purge Manager** is now accessible from the SRS Document Queue and allows you to purge large numbers of documents based on date, user or status.

• You can now preview completed documents and email them directly from the preview screen, or print to the SYSPRO default printer (or a specific printer).

The **Maintain SRS Document Templates** setup program allows you to specify whether a document should be physically printed (i.e. the print process can generate the document and store it in the database, without printing it). Although this option is also available for client-side printing, the generated document is simply discarded.

The **Admin System Setup** program has been updated to cater for the configuration of automatic purge settings for the document queue.

# Where can I see the change?

There is a new **Document Printing** group in the **Reporting** tab of the **Admin System Setup** program which includes the option: **Automatically purge queue** and an entry field to specify the number of days. These options are only available for server-side reporting.

New filter options for document destination, date and status are available in the **SRS Document Queue** program. There is also a button at the top of the screen which opens the **Purge Manager**, and a **Document Preview** is available when you select the **View** Document link in the **Document** column.

Several new activities have been added to the SYSPRO Document Services activity group to control operator access to the **SRS Document Queue** program. These activities are prefixed with **SRS Server**.

The **Maintain SRS Document Templates** setup program allows you to select **Do not print** from the **Add Printer** dropdown on the **Printers** pane.

# Why was this done?

Although you could configure a lookup table for a specific custom form type and field, there was no way to share this lookup table across other forms and fields (i.e. lookup tables had to be duplicated for each field).

### What was done?

The following programs were changed to cater for a shared lookup table functionality:

Admin Custom Forms Entry

This program now caters for two new types of lookup in the Field Validation (i.e. Lookup shared (mandatory) and Lookup shared (not mandatory)

This program now caters for two new types of lookup in the Field Validation (i.e. Lookup shared (mandatory) and Lookup shared (not mandatory)

### Admin Custom Form Validation Lookup

This is a new program that handles the selection and maintenance of the shared lookup table.

The changes are available when selecting **Custom Forms** from the **Administration** tab of the SYSPRO Ribbon bar.

### Why was this done?

AR\_TRIAL\_BALANCE

This forms part of the enhancement that was released in Port 005 relating to the ageing of AR invoices based on user-defined ageing buckets instead of the Accounts Receivable period end dates.

### What was done?

The **AR Trial Balance** caters for the new AR invoice terms to age according to the user defined fixed buckets.

The **Show Statements** function of the **AR Customer Query** program (selected from the **Query** menu) caters for the new AR invoice terms to age according to the user defined fixed buckets.

# Where can I see the change?

If you are using the new terms code option and user-defined ageing buckets, then the changes are visible when you produce the **AR Trial Balance** and when viewing **Customer Statements** in a browser window within the **AR Customer Query** program.
