## Why was this done?

This forms part of the ongoing improvements and additions to the SYSPRO Espresso suite of applications.

## What was done?

A **Job Entry** application to create and maintain jobs within Espresso is available as a purchasable application.

## Where can I see the change?

The applications and changes will be made available on the standard SYSPRO Espresso Menu and the SYSPRO App Store.

## Why was this done?

There was a requirement to enhance the SYSPRO Espresso licensing options by providing improved flexibility at a reduced cost.

Currently, Espresso licenses are provided on a per-seat (named user) basis. If, for example, you require 100 people to use Espresso in your organization then you require a license for 100 Espresso seats. This would enable you to configure up to 100 SYSPRO operators with the Espresso user license enabled. These are known as **full use** Espresso seats.

## What was done?

There are two new Espresso licensing options:

- Espresso Linked User

If a site is licensed for 80 concurrent users (80 SYSPRO concurrent user license), selecting this option will allow up to 80 selected operators to use Espresso.

The cost of this setup option is significantly lower than if each of the 80 operators required a **full use** Espresso license. If more users are required to use Espresso, for example 100, then these additional 20 users will require a **full use** Espresso license. The cost of this license is significantly lower than if each of the 80 Operators required a **full use** Espresso license.

- External Espresso Users

This allows a SYSPRO site to provide an Espresso license to their customer, allowing them limited access to queries and transaction posting apps for a specific customer.

This allows their customers to manage the interaction with the SYSPRO site providing improved collaboration, less management at the SYSPRO site and generally improved customer service and responsiveness with reduced cost.

Until now, each of the SYSPRO sites' customers needed their own operator code in SYSPRO and a **full use** Espresso license. Those operator codes would be restricted to only have access to the appropriate customer's details. However the cost of the **full use** Espresso license was relatively high considering the tightly restricted access and limited apps that they would have access to.

If the customer requires access to more details than those against a selected customer account then a **full use** Espresso license will still be required as before.

## Where can I see the change?

- A new **Espresso Linked users** option has been added to the **Admin System Setup** program. Enabling this checkbox allows each of your SYSPRO concurrent licensed users to have access to Espresso. This is stored in the `IMPACT.INI` file using the `IMPESL=1` tag (where 1 means checked).
- The program has also been enhanced to allow entry at the **Number of Espresso External seats** field. This will typically match the number specified in your license and can be a 6-digit number. This is stored in the `IMPACT.INI` file using the `IMPESX=999999` tag.
- You can view the new Espresso system-wide settings in the **Company Maintenance** and **Admin Company Setup** programs. These values will be verified when importing a `LICENSE.XML` file containing the new information.
- A new **Espresso license type** dropdown field has been added to the **Operator Maintenance** program from which you can select if the operator is a full use Espresso user, a Linked Espresso user or an External Espresso user.

When defined as an External Espresso user you must select **02 - Customer** at the **Functional Role** dropdown field on the **e.net** tab, and you must assign a single customer code to the operator code.

- When logging into an Espresso application the appropriate license validation will be performed.

## Why was this done?

There was a requirement in Sales Orders and Quotes to reuse a configuration when maintaining a sales order or quotation line.

## What was done?

A new option: **Allow in process configurations** has been added to the **Options** tab of the **Product Config Header Maintenance** program.

This option is only available if:

- The **Sales orders** and/or **Quotations** and **Estimates** options are selected on the **General** tab of this program.
- The **Retain configuration libraries** option is selected on the **Options** tab of this program.
- You are generating a parent part (**Stocked**, **Non-stocked** or **Both stocked & non-stocked** are selected at the **Type** field in the Parent group on the **Options** tab of this program).

Once this is enabled the **Product Configurator** option will be available from the dropdown menu in the **SO Entry** and **Quotation Entry** and Quotation Estimates programs.

## Where can I see the change?

The following programs have been updated to cater for this new option:

- **SO Entry**

A Product Configurator menu option is available against a sales order line when that line is linked to a configuration. This option is not currently available for the web product configurator. The following order types can reuse a configuration: orders, billing, scheduled orders, forward orders.

- **Product Configurator Wizard**

New in process options are available in the Product Configurator Wizard, including:

- Update price against sales order/quotation line.
- Update list price for parent stock code.
- Update cost for parent stock code.
- An option to automatically update the changes to the configuration. If this option is selected, you will have an option to select to use the BOM components to replace the job material allocations. Only those components generated through the configurator and saved to the new library will be copied to the job.
- An option to review the configuration changes. This will open the new **Review of Components and Operations** program.

- **Quotation Entry**

A Product Configurator menu option is available against a quotation detail line when that line is linked to a configuration.

When creating a quotation line from the product configurator, a configurator will only be able to be reused if the configuration is created from the stocked tab. You can create stocked and non-stocked parent codes from this link.

- **Quotation Copy to Estimates**

The configuration can be reused in process when creating an estimate.

- **SO Query**

Two new hyperlinks - **Product Code** and **Library Code** - are available on the **Sales Order Line Information** display form. The **Product Code** hyperlink calls the **Product Configurator Configurations** program and the **Library Code** hyperlink calls the **Product Configurator Library Selections** program.

- **Quotation Query**

Two new hyperlinks - **Product Code** and **Library Code** - are available on the **Quotation Details Values** display form. The **Product Code** hyperlink calls the **Product Configurator Configurations** program and the **Library Code** hyperlink calls the **Product Configurator Library Selections** program.

- New programs include:

- **Review of Components and Operations**

This program is called from the Product Configurator Wizard when the **Review changes** option is selected.

- **Product Configurator Library Selections**

This program displays the components and operations of a library associated with a quotation/sales order line.

## Why was this done?

There was a requirement to track any changes made when a job, labor or material allocation is created or maintained.

## What was done?

An amendment journal has been added to track all labor or material allocations that are added, changed or deleted.

An amendment journal will be created when you perform any of the following transactions against a live job (no amendment journals are created for snapshot jobs):

- Create the job

The following programs have been changed: **WIP Job Entry, Product Configurator Job Creation, MRP Job Review, Quotation Job Loading, RMA Issue & Receipt - Create sales.**

- Maintain the job

The following programs have been changed: **MRP Job Review, WIP Job Entry.**

- Delete a job

The following programs have been changed: **WIP Job Entry, WIP Period End.**

- Add a labor or material allocation

The following programs have been changed: **Product Configurator Job Creation, Quotation Job Loading, RMA Issue & Receipt - Create sales, WIP Add an Operation, WIP Material Allocations - Maintenance.**

- Change a labor or material allocation

The following programs have been changed: **WIP Job and Op Maintenance, WIP Material Allocations - Maintenance.**

- Delete a labor or material allocation

The following programs have been changed: **WIP Material Allocations - Maintenance, WIP Job and Op Maintenance.**

- Place a job on hold

The following programs have been changed: **ECC Change ECO Status, WIP Job Confirmation Review, WIP Job Entry.**

- Confirm a job

The following programs have been changed: **WIP Job Confirmation Review, WIP Job Entry.**

## Where can I see the change?

- A new option: **Capture job amendment journals** is available in the **WIP Setup** program.
- A new hyperlink is available in the **WIP Query** program on the **Additional Information** form to view amendment journals.

This hyperlink is enabled when the **Capture job amendment journals** option is selected in the **WIP Setup** program.

- A new **Browse on Job Amendment Journals** program is available on the SYSPRO menu.
- A new **Job Amendment Journals Query** business object is available to view the new job amendment journals.

### Why was this done?

A new business object was created to enable e.net Solutions developers to develop applications for requisition transfer setup functionality.

### Why was this done?

There was a requirement to automate the **AR Collector Run Maintenance** program.

### What was done?

An automatic function has been added to the **AR Collector Run Maintenance** program to apply and allocate cash collected, to the outstanding invoice amounts captured in the collector run.

There is also a facility to generate and populate an AR payment run automatically with all the relevant data from the collector run, to ensure a quicker and easier posting process.

The **AR Post Dated Check Statuses** program now allows you to post cleared PD checks and to automatically create the AR payment run.

## Where can I see the change?

The changes are visible in the **AR Collector Run Maintenance** and **AR Post Dated Check Statuses** programs.

## Supply and demand control extended to MRP calculation

## Why was this done?

This forms part of an enhancement that was released in Port 011 relating to the control of supply and demand included in the MRP calculation to extend beyond company level. For example, although you could exclude all purchase orders and requisitions as supply in the calculation, you could not exclude specific purchase orders and requisitions or individual purchase order/requisition lines.

## What was done?

The facility to exclude specific sales orders at header and line level has been provided when running the MRP calculation. When a sales order (or sales order line) is excluded from the MRP calculation, it is no longer seen as a source of demand and if a shortage exists, no suggested purchase orders, requisitions or jobs are raised for the item(s) on that specific sales order/line and any supplying jobs are not suggested to be cancelled.

## Where can I see the change?

A new field and a column: **Include in MRP** has been added to the header and listview respectively of the **SO Entry** program that displays the inclusion or exclusion from the MRP calculation.
