There was a requirement to add additional filter and purge options to the **SO Contract Pricing Purge** program.

What was done?

A new user interface has been created with additional options, including:

- Customer selection
- Buying groups selection
- Contract pricing method selection
- After processing completed options.

What is being done?

Electronic Signatures are being added to the **Purchase Orders** module. The changes are still in progress and will be available to implement at a later date.

Why was this done?

This forms part of the requirement in Sales Orders and Quotes to reuse a configuration when maintaining a sales order or quotation line.

What was done?

The **MRP Requirements Calculation** program has been updated to cater for the **Allow in process configurations** option.

When running the MRP Calculation with the **Schedule specific supply** setup option enabled, a job (associated with a quotation that has been created using the Product Configurator with the **Allow in process configurations** option enabled) will be scheduled according to the dates on the quotation.

Where can I see the change?

You can view the forecast schedule details in the **MRP Material Requirements Query** program.

Note that the quotation line number is not used on the job only the quotation number - as only the quotation number is setup on the job.

Why was this done?

A new business object was created to enable e.net Solutions developers to develop applications for requisition user maintenance functionality.

Where can I see the change?

CMS organization list objects now support dynamic lists

Why was this done?

There was a requirement for the Organization List Query business object (CMSQOL) and the Organization List Post business object (CMSTOL) to support dynamic organization lists as they have only supported static organization lists.

Dynamic lists, supported by the Contact Management System, allow you to define conditional logic to include or exclude customers, suppliers or accounts (known as organizations) to be applied at run-time.

The generated list can be used by the Contact Query, Contact sync to Outlook or the Organization list query business object allowing access by third party apps.

For example, if you are an account manager overseeing the coastal region, you could include a condition **Where Branch = North** against all customers. When you next use the Contact Query and select this list, all your customers would be shown even if for example, 3 new customers had been added recently.

What was done?

The following changes have been made to the CMSQOL and CMSTOL business objects:

- CMSQOL
 - The `filename` function has been enhanced to return information about dynamic lists.
- CMSTOL
 - The `Add list` function has been enhanced to allow dynamic lists to be specified.
- Contact Dynamic List Query Business Object - CMSQDL
 - The Business Object that a developer can invoke to evaluate an existing organization list and return the organizations that match the current conditions (CMSQDL) already handles conditional lists as of SYSPRO 6.1 SP1.

Where can I see the change?

This change only affects 3rd party developers who use the business objects CMSQOL and CMSTOL.

View material and labor allocations for a job

Why was this done?

There was a requirement to be able to view the material and labor allocations for a job from the **WIP Query** program.

What was done?

New listviews have been added for Material Allocations and Operations Allocations.

Where can I see the change?

You can select the **Material Allocations** and **Operations Allocations** listviews from the View Panes option.

Use the Field Chooser against the listview to ensure all the available fields have been added.
